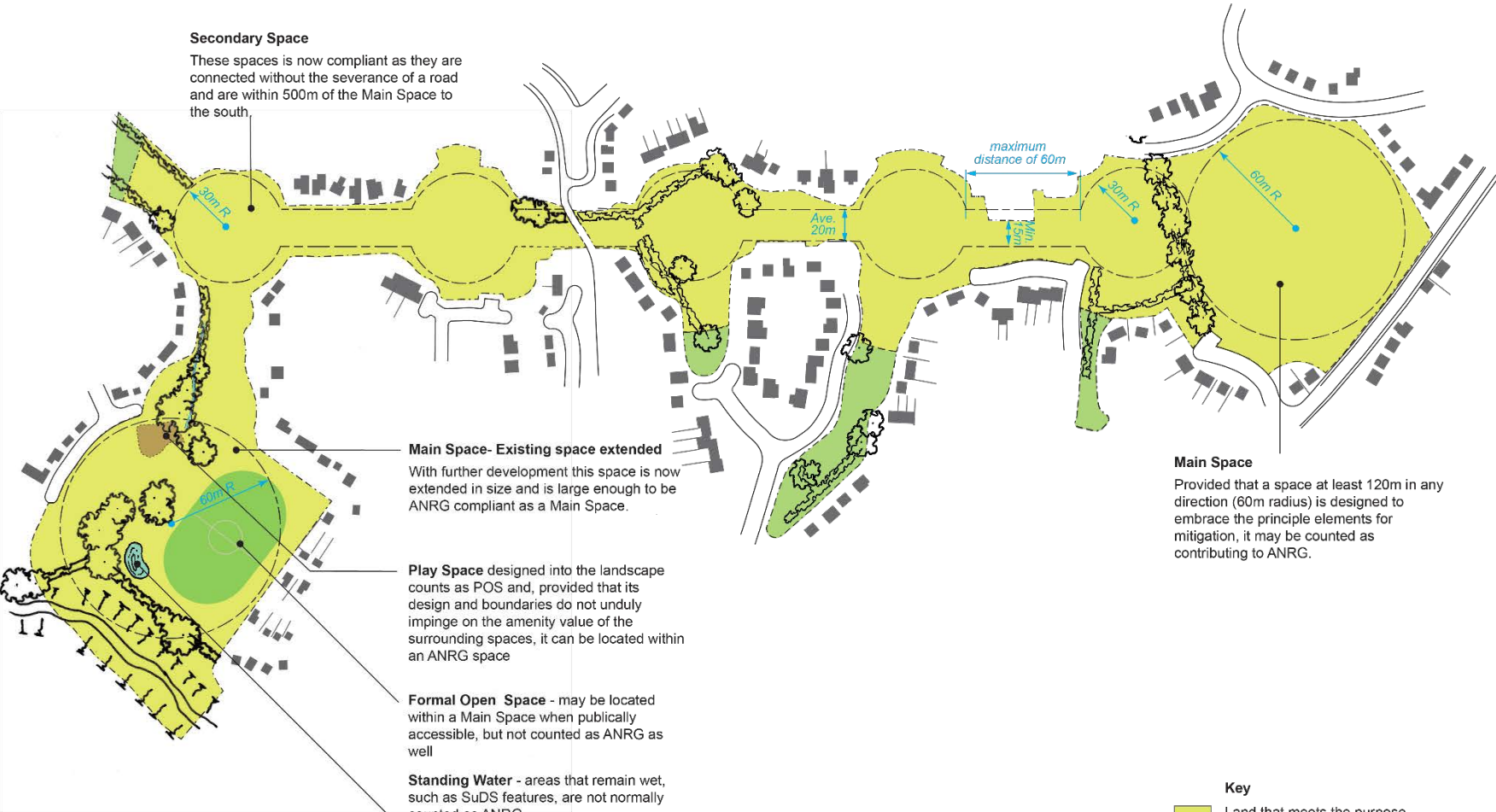


# ANRG Diagram 3: Extending the network

Some double counting issues explained

## Secondary Space

These spaces are now compliant as they are connected without the severance of a road and are within 500m of the Main Space to the south.



## Main Space- Existing space extended

With further development this space is now extended in size and is large enough to be ANRG compliant as a Main Space.

**Play Space** designed into the landscape counts as POS and, provided that its design and boundaries do not unduly impinge on the amenity value of the surrounding spaces, it can be located within an ANRG space

**Formal Open Space** - may be located within a Main Space when publically accessible, but not counted as ANRG as well

**Standing Water** - areas that remain wet, such as SuDS features, are not normally counted as ANRG. However, they should be sympathetic to the landscape so that planted banks and wetland habitat can be counted towards ANRG or POS if they are accessible all year round, and at the discretion of the LPA

## Main Space

Provided that a space at least 120m in any direction (60m radius) is designed to embrace the principle elements for mitigation, it may be counted as contributing to ANRG.

## Key

- Land that meets the purpose of ANRG or public open space
- Land that meets the purposes of POS but is not dimensionally compliant to meet those of ANRG
- SuDS - wet areas that cannot be counted as ANRG
