



## **Adoption Statement**

### **Mitigation for Recreational Impacts On New Forest European Sites Supplementary Planning Document**

Notice is hereby given that, in accordance with Regulations 11 and 14 of the Town & Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2012, New Forest District Council formally adopted the Mitigation for Recreational Impacts on New Forest European Sites Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 5 May 2021.

The Supplementary Planning Document has been prepared to provide support to the implementation of the adopted 'Policy ENV1: Mitigating the impact of development on International Nature Conservation sites' from the New Forest District's (outside the National Park) Local Plan 2016-2036 Part 1: Planning Strategy (adopted in July 2020).

The Supplementary Planning Document replaces the 'Mitigation Strategy for European Sites: Recreational Pressure from Residential Development', adopted by the Council in June 2014.

The Mitigation for Recreational Impacts on New Forest European Sites Supplementary Planning Document was subject to a six-week period of public consultation from 9 January to 21 February 2021. A summary of the main issues raised during this consultation and how they were taken into account is set out in the Consultation Statement.
