Supplementary Planning Document

Notice is hereby given that, in accordance with Regulations 11 and 14 of the Town & Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2012, New Forest District Council formally adopted the Parking Standards Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 6 April 2022.

The Supplementary Planning Document has been prepared to provide support to the implementation of the adopted Policies CCC2: 'Safe and sustainable travel', Policy IMPL2: 'Development standards' and ENV3: 'Design quality and local distinctiveness'. from the New Forest District's (outside the National Park) Local Plan 2016-2036 Part 1: Planning Strategy (adopted in July 2020).

The Supplementary Planning Document replaces the 'Parking Standards', adopted by the Council in October 2012.

The Parking Standards Supplementary Planning Document was subject to a period of public consultation from 26 November 2021 to 14 January 2022. A summary of the main issues raised during this consultation and how they were taken into account is set out in the Consultation Statement. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 6 July 2022 (3 months after the date of adoption).
