



## **Adoption Statement**

### **Air Quality in New Development Supplementary Planning Document**

Notice is hereby given that, in accordance with Regulations 11 and 14 of the Town & Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2012, New Forest District Council formally adopted the Air Quality in New Development Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 1 June 2022.

The Supplementary Planning Document has been prepared to provide support to the Local Plan 2016-2036 Part 1: Planning Strategy, and in particular Objective SO2 (Biodiversity and environmental quality) and Policy CCC1 (Safe and healthy communities) which aims to prevent pollution or hazards which prejudice the health or safety of communities.

The Air Quality in New Development SPD was subject to a period of public consultation from 18 February 2022 to 1 April 2022. A summary of the main issues raised during this consultation and how they were taken into account is set out in the Council's Consultation Statement.

Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 1 September 2022 (3 months after the date of adoption).
