AIM

Supporting local cultural delivery partners and communities to develop impactful cultural projects for their areas.

ACTIVITIES

- Delivery of creative hubs for LGBTQ+ young people in New Milton and Sway.
- The development of Folio a professional partnership, network and community for creative and cultural professionals living and/or working in the New Forest district. Expanding the Elevate programme at Forest Forge. Elevate is a two-week creative work experience programme for young people aged 14 -18.
- Delivery of outdoor and rural theatre development project, Focus on Theatre, commissioning three new original theatre works, Life's a Beach, Future First and Suitcase Stories
- Working with the National Park Authority and local home-educated young people to design and create a BBC Gardeners World showcase garden, to then be permanently rehomed and cared for in the New Forest.
- Supporting the initiation of small scale projects, for big impact, including Pride 2024, creative drop-in sessions in Totton provided by Fluid Motion, and new arts classes for Broadleaf Co-op.
