New Forest District Council can only issue pleasure boat licences to vessels operating in Category A, B, C and D waters. This applies to the following areas as define in MSN1837 (M) amendment 2;			
Solent (category D) Inside the IOW within an area bounded by lines drawn between the church spire, West Wittering, to Trinity Church, Bembridge, to the eastward and the Needles and Hurst Point to the westward.			
Southampton Water (category C) Within a line from Calshot Castle to Hook Beacon.			
Beaulieu River (category C) Within Beaulieu River not eastward of a North/South line through Inchmery House.			
Keyhaven Lake (category C) Within a line drawn due North from Hurst Point Low Light to Keyhaven Marshes.
